Named after its shimmering alkaline lake, the park is famous for its tree-climbing lions, large elephant families, grazing zebra and buffalo, abundant baboons, and a variety of antelope.</p> <p>Lake Manyara is also a paradise for bird lovers, with over 400 recorded species—including flamingos, pelicans, storks and impressive birds of prey. 3	THU 27 May	Ngorongoro Crater (Karatu)	<p>A highlight awaits you this morning as you depart to explore what is commonly referred to as the World's largest wildlife zoo.</p> <p>After breakfast, you head to the crater and then descend with a picnic lunch, through the early morning mists and 2,000 feet into the crater. Ngorongoro Crater is the world's largest intact volcanic caldera. Due to its size and diversity, the crater floor is comprised of several distinct areas, ranging from forest, swamps, lakes and springs to open grassland and some sandy dunes. It's an awesome wildlife experience. The Crater is home to an estimated 30,000 animals, making it one of the most densely populated wildlife areas in the world. Ngorongoro Conservation Area is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a popular destination for wildlife safaris and outdoor adventure activities.</p>	Farm House Valley Lodge	B/L/D
