8	SAT 28 Nov	Vidin, Bulgaria	<p>Explore Vidin, one of Bulgaria's oldest cities, and surrounding areas with a choice of excursions. Alternatively, visit a local home for a demonstration of traditional Bulgarian yogurt and Banitsa, a pastry you will also get to make.
