LADIES ONLY KENYA ADVENTURE

20 JUN: ARRIVE NAIROBI

On arrival, you will be met and transferred to the hotel. Relax and enjoy your first day at leisure with the opportunity to meet your fellow lady travellers while enjoying dinner at the hotel.

21 JUN: NAIROBI DISCOVERY

Today, we discover Nairobi on a full-day guided tour where you will experience many of the city's philanthropic and conservation high points, mixed in with historic and cultural highlights.

Enjoy visits to the informative and interactive Giraffe Centre, the Karen Blixen farmhouse from "Out of Africa" fame – now a museum as well as the Beads Factory, which employs over 300 women. Lunch will be at the Karen Blixen Coffee Garden. Return to your hotel. *Tamarind Tree Hotel (BL)*

*** HIGHLIGHT:** View some of Nairobi's best attractions with the chance to get "kissed" by a giraffe.

22/23/24 JUN: SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE

Travel to Samburu National Reserve, located in Northern Kenya. On arrival check in to Ashnil Samburu Camp, a luxury tented camp set between a backdrop of the Ol Olokwe mountains and with each tent featuring a decked terrace with views of the Ewaso Nyiro River. During your stay, visit Umoja Village, a matriarchal community created exclusively for females escaping male violence. Umoja, which means "unity" in Swahili, started with 15 women and now has more than 50 women and their children in the village, made up of homes the women have constructed for each other and a school, all surrounded by a fence of thorny branches. The women make money selling honey and handmade beads to tourists. Game drives, nature walks and a cultural visit to the Samburu Village are included. *Ashnil Samburu Camp - 3 nights (BLD)*

*** HIGHLIGHT:** Game viewing in Samburu plus a Visit to the female only village of Umoja to learn about their struggles and how they have rebuilt.

25/26 JUN: LAKE NAKURU

Enjoy a morning game drive and breakfast before heading off on a journey to Lake Nakuru National Park. Located on the floor of the Kenyan Great Rift Valley system, this fracture in the earth's crust stretches around 6,500 km from The Middle East to Southern Africa. During our stay enjoy game drives around the lake shore - home to a good population of rhino.

On arrival, check in to your lodge for 2 nights. Enjoy lunch before going on safari to explore the Park, which has one of the Rift Valley soda lakes. It is often home to flamingos along with a wide variety of wildlife and birdlife. Enjoy game drives during your stay. *Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge - 2 nights (BLD)*

*** HIGHLIGHT:** Enjoy game drives in this unique location and you may even get the chance to view flamingos in the lake.

27/28/29 JUN: THE MASAI MARA

Depart Lake Nakuru and head south towards Kenya's premier wildlife arena - the Masai Mara National Reserve.

Stop enroute to visit 'Beats of Beads', a Kenyan non-profit organisation - a Women Empowerment Art-centre. Visit the only museum in Africa dedicated to the art of East African beading – on jugs, leather bags, loin cloths, as well as an impressive collection of head and neck ornaments.

The knowledgeable guides add to the experience showing the workspace where skilled Maasai women teach you the art of beading while interacting with them. The nearby store allows the women to sell their art with dignity and under fair trade.

On arrival at our camp, check in for 3 nights. The Masai Mara is known for its spectacular wildlife and large numbers of elephants, lions, rhino, buffalo, wildebeest, giraffe, zebra and more and the possibility to view the annual wildebeest migration. During your stay enjoy the chance to visit a local school.

Zebra Plains Mara Camp is located below Oldonyo Oloip Ridge, home to the Moniko Pride of lions, and with best views of the open plains of the Mara frequented by giraffes, zebras, impalas, topis, buffalos and many other plain game. There is also a water-hole in front of the camp that gets busy during dry season.

During our stay, enjoy game drives throughout the reserve with the chance to view the annual migration (subject to climatic conditions). *Zebra Plains Mara Camp - 3 nights (BLD)*

*** HIGHLIGHT:** Discover what makes game-viewing in the Masai Mara so special.

*** HIGHLIGHT:** Enjoy a visit to Beats of Beads and a local school.
