7 SEP: ARRIVE IN CASABLANCA

Your Moroccan adventure begins with a warm airport pickup in Casablanca. After settling into your hotel, your first cultural stop is the impressive Hassan II Mosque—one of the largest in the world, dramatically positioned over the Atlantic. You'll also visit the charming Habous Quarter, known for its blend of Moroccan and French design.

In the evening, enjoy a welcome dinner at the iconic Rick's Café, a re-creation of the famous setting from Casablanca. It's the perfect place to meet your fellow travellers and toast to the journey ahead. *Radisson Gauthier La Citadelle (D)*

08 SEP: RABAT & CHEFCHAOUEN

After breakfast, the group departs for Rabat, Morocco's elegant capital. A short orientation gives you a taste of its serene boulevards and landmarks before heading into the Rif Mountains and onto the enchanting Blue City of Chefchaouen, with time to explore its winding, vividly coloured streets.

09 SEP: CHEFCHAOUEN

Spend the day discovering Chefchaouen and its unique history and atmosphere. Take your time wandering the beautiful blue-painted alleys and browsing artisan shops. Following a leisurely lunch, the afternoon is free for shopping and relaxing.

10 SEP: CHEFCHAOUEN to FES

After breakfast, our drive continues to Fes, via Volubilis, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the best-preserved Roman city in Morocco. Explore the site and enjoy lunch at a vineyard before heading to Fes where you'll check in and settle into Morocco's cultural capital. *Barceló Fes (BL)*

11 SEP: A DAY IN FES

Today, delve into the rich traditions of Fes with a guided walking tour. Highlights include the Royal Palace gates, a visit to a historic Medersa, and the city's famed tanneries. Lunch is served in the heart of the old city, followed by continued exploration of souks and artisan workshops. The evening is free for you to enjoy at your own pace. *Barceló Fes (BL)*

12 SEP: THE SAHARA DESERT

After an early breakfast, the journey turns toward the Sahara. Drive through scenic Middle Atlas landscapes, stopping in Berber towns and valleys along the way. By late afternoon, arrive at the edge of the desert for a sunset camel ride into your luxury desert camp. That evening, enjoy a traditional campfire dinner with tribal music and stargazing, an unforgettable night beneath the stars. *Camp Chebbi (BD)*

13 SEP: SAHARA TO SKOURA

Optional: Rise early to watch the sunrise over the dunes or try sandboarding before breakfast. Then, the group sets off through the dramatic Dades Gorges, stopping for lunch along the way.

In the late afternoon, arrive in the lush Skoura Oasis and check into your boutique kasbah, where a peaceful dinner awaits.

14 SEP: SKOURA TO MARRAKECH

Today's drive takes you across the High Atlas Mountains, with visits to the famous Aït Ben Haddou (a UNESCO-listed village and film location) and the scenic Tizi N'Tichka pass. Arrive in Marrakech and check into your beautiful riad. The evening is yours to relax or explore the medina nearby. *Jaal Riad Resort (B)*

15 SEP: COOKING CLASS & CULTURAL TOUR

Start the day with a private Moroccan cooking class led by a local "Dada" (traditional chef), followed by lunch made by your own hands. In the afternoon, enjoy a guided tour of Marrakech's lively Medina, Souks, and legendary Spice Market. Enjoy your evening freely or indulge in a local dining experience of your choice.

16 SEP: GARDENS, MUSEUMS AND FAREWELL DINNER

After breakfast, visit the serene Majorelle Gardens, once owned by Yves Saint Laurent, and the adjacent YSL Museum, offering insight into fashion, art, and Moroccan inspiration. The afternoon is free to unwind, shop, or enjoy the Riad's amenities. In the evening, gather for a farewell dinner at the chic Kabana Rooftop, overlooking the lights of Marrakech. *Jaal Riad Resort (BD)*

17 SEP: DEPART MARRAKECH
