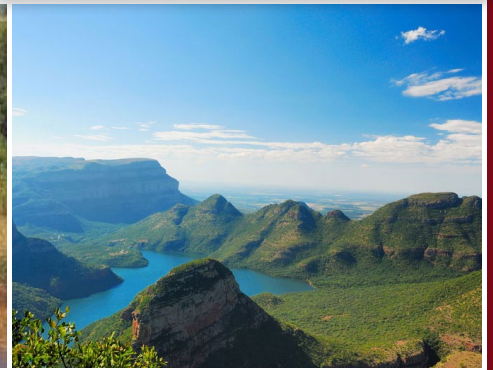

## 7 JUN: JOHANNESBURG

On arrival in Johannesburg, you will be met and assisted to your shuttle transfer service to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. In the evening we meet in the hotel reception for a welcome briefing on the tour and a chance to meet your fellow travellers. *Garden Court OR Tambo*

## 8 JUN: HAZYVIEW

This morning we leave for Mpumalanga, dropping several hundred feet into the lush subtropical region of the Lowveld. Travel along the circular Panorama Route, visiting the view sites of the Blyde River Canyon, home to the Three Rondavels and one of the natural wonders of Africa; gasp at the glory of God's Window, then visit Bourke's Luck Potholes. *Hazyview Sun (B)*

**\* HIGHLIGHT:** View the spectacular Panorama Route

## 9 JUN: KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

Today we have a bright and early start to experience the wonders of exploring the Kruger National Park. Enjoy a thrilling open-vehicle game drive through the famous Kruger National in search for the Big Five - Lion, Leopard, Elephant, Rhino and Buffalo and keep a look out for other amazing birds & wildlife. This world-renowned game reserve supports the largest variety of wildlife species on the African continent. Keep a lookout for the wonderful flora and bird life that abounds. Return to hotel for afternoon at leisure. *Hazyview Sun (B)*

**\* HIGHLIGHT:** Enjoy an Open-Vehicle game drive

## 10 JUN: eSWATINI

Travel to eSwatini (formerly known as Swaziland), an independent Kingdom within the borders of South Africa, known for its scenery, crafts and colourful indigenous culture. Experience a visit to a village to discover the charming locals and their traditions. *Foresters Arms (B)*

## 11 JUN: ST LUCIA AND SURROUNDS

Journey through eSwatini, visiting Ngwenya Glass, where a small group of eSwatini craftsmen and women create beautiful handmade items from recycled glass. Our next stop is The Swazi Candles Centre where you will experience local artisans creating colourful, handmade candles. Continue into the Kingdom of KwaZulu-Natal where ancient traditions and modern cultures of both Zulu and Settler have combined into a vibrant society living in peace and harmony. *eZulwiniGame Lodge (B)*

## 12 JUN: ST LUCIA TO DURBAN

Enjoy an early morning open vehicle game drive in the Hluhluwe-iMfolozi Game Reserve, before heading off to Durban. An orientation tour of Durban, that travels along the Golden Mile, the beachfront promenade, The Point Waterfront, harbour and the Durban Botanic Gardens introduces us to this vibrant, multicultural seaside city. *Premier Hotel Umhlanga (B)*

**\* HIGHLIGHT:** Game drive in Hluhluwe-iMfolozi Game Reserve and Orientation tour of Durban.

## 13 JUN: DRAKENSBURG

Today we head into the majestic Southern Drakensberg Mountains. We visit the impressive 300 foot high Howick Falls, located in the KwaZulu-Natal Midlands town of Howick.

Our journey continues through the Southern Midlands Meander Route, arriving at our hotel, situated on a scenic World Heritage site, mid-afternoon. Your afternoon is at leisure to enjoy the optional activities (own account). Enjoy a sumptuous dinner at your hotel. *Goodersons Drakensberg Gardens (BD)*

**\* HIGHLIGHT:** Visit to Howick Falls.

## 14 JUN: DRAKENSBURG

Enjoy a full day at leisure to soak up the surroundings of the magnificent Southern Drakensberg Mountains. Consider joining a thrilling 4x4 tour up the spectacular Sani Pass into the mountain Kingdom of Lesotho (optional and for own account). Enjoy an evening dinner at your hotel with a wide variety of local specialities to choose from. *Goodersons Drakensberg Gardens (BD)*

**\*\* SUGGESTION:** Take a 4x4 up the Sani Pass into the Kingdom of Lesotho

## 15/16 JUN: EASTERN CAPE COAST

Continue south to the birthplace of Nelson Mandela (fondly known as Madiba). Enroute we see the old traditional way of life in the former homeland area known as the Transkei. Travel past Nelson Mandela's birthplace and house, arriving late afternoon for dinner at our lodge on the beautiful, unspoilt Eastern Cape Coast. Next day, awake to the sounds of the crashing waves and enjoy a morning at leisure at the beach then set off south to the Tsitsikamma Forest. *Crawfords Beach Lodge (BD) / Tsitsikamma Village Inn (B)*

## 17 JUN: KNYSNA

Visit the beautiful Tsitsikamma Forest. A short walk to the Storms River Mouth offers some magnificent views of the gorge and river below. Arrive in Knysna, known as the oyster box of South Africa. Enjoy dinner at the lodge. *Knysna Hollow Country Estate (BD)*

## 18 JUN: OUDTSHOORN

Travel inland over the Outeniqua Pass to Oudtshoorn, known as the 'feather capital of the world' because of its ostrich industry. We visit a working ostrich farm and then explore the famous Cango Caves. *Protea Hotel Riempe Estate (B)*

**\* HIGHLIGHT:** Visit an Ostrich Farm & the Cango Caves.

## 19/20 JUN: CAPE TOWN

Journey along the famous Route 62 and through the Little Karoo, ending in Cape Town. On the way stop off to sample wines in Calitzdorp, before continuing via Worcester and the Huguenot Tunnel, in to Cape Town late afternoon. Next day is at leisure. Cape Town is packed with sightseeing attractions, excellent bars, cafes, restaurants as well as colourful craft markets or perhaps join a sightseeing Cape Winelands or Cape Peninsula tour (own account). *Anew Hotel Green Point (B)*

## 21 JUN: DEPART

After breakfast, transfer to Cape Town International airport.
